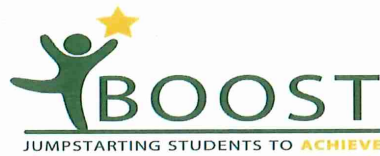
Extra PTA raffle tickets can be obtained from the office when you return your sold ones. Thank you to those who have sold all of their first lot of tickets.

Volunteering is a work of heart

We are looking for a volunteer tutor to support students in Literacy at Tinwald School.

Hi, my name is Helen Breach, and I coordinate the Boost programme in Mid Canterbury. Presently, we are in 20 schools in Ashburton, Methven and the Foothills with 200 students and over 40 volunteer tutors. This is a locally funded child literacy initiative, which has been set up to support and improve the literacy success rates for our children. It is aimed at children 7 to 9 years' old who need a BOOST to achieve in literacy.

- *The programme runs for 30 weeks (March to November)
- *2 hours of tuition twice a week
- *Tuition is at the school, in the morning
- *BOOST is a 30-week programme during school terms and full training is given
- *As volunteers if you need time away, we work it out
- *The BOOST programme compliments the school programme
- *Information about the 'Steps' approach can be viewed at www.stepsweb.com
- *BOOST supply all of the materials required (laptops, workbooks, resources)
- *BOOST is free to the school and the child

If you think you could be a volunteer tutor for BOOST at Tinwald School, we would love to have you! We fund your police check and full training and support is given.

This is a very rewarding program where you see success and confidence in students develop over the year and stay connected with your community.

Hitting Squad – 45 mins [Orange & Green] This group helps our Orange & Green players fast track their skills towards playing Interclub tennis, putting into practice what they have learnt mid week. 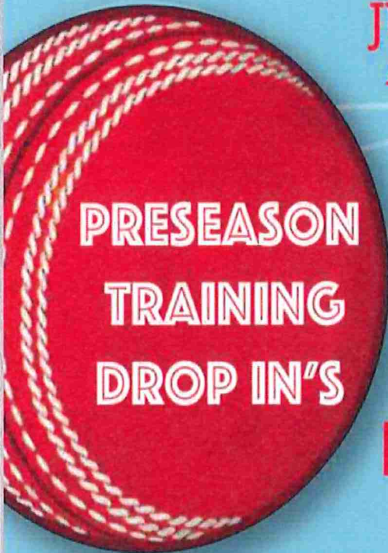

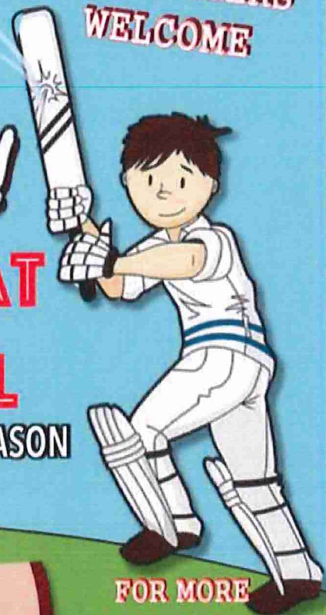

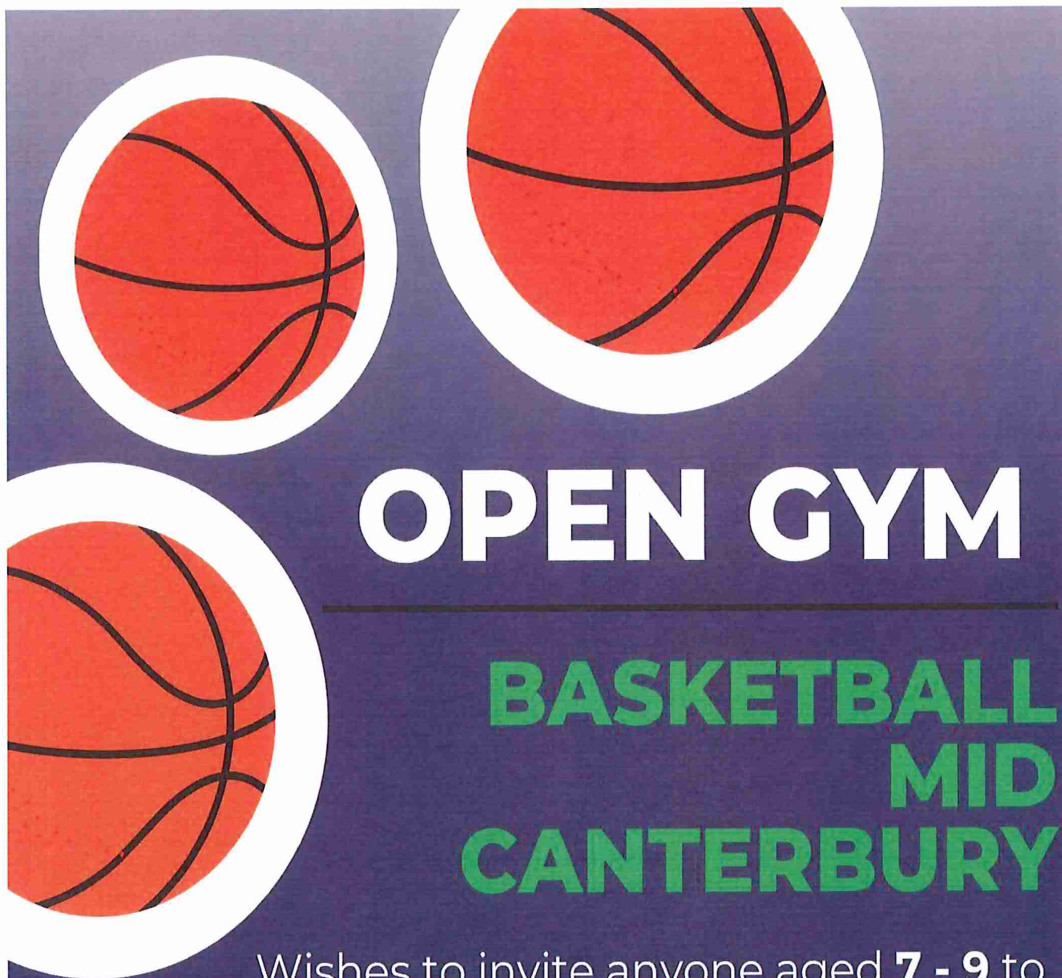

BASKETBALL MID CANTERBURY

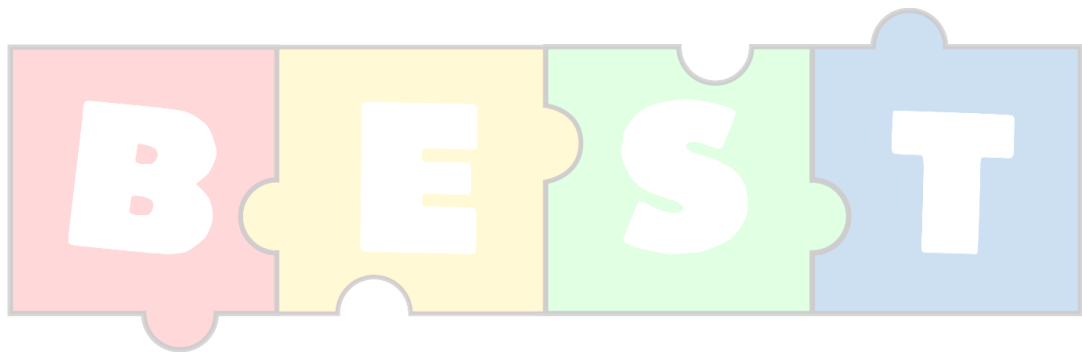
Wishes to invite anyone aged **7 - 9** to attend an open gym session on **Wednesdays 3:15 - 5:30**.
