## Volunteering is a work of heart

### We are looking for a volunteer tutor to support students in Literacy at Tinwald School.

Hi, my name is Helen Breach, and I coordinate the Boost programme in Mid Canterbury. Presently, we are in 20 schools in Ashburton, Methven and the Foothills with 200 students and over 40 volunteer tutors. This is a locally funded child literacy initiative, which has been set up to support and improve the literacy success rates for our children. It is aimed at children 7 to 9 years' old who need a BOOST to achieve in literacy.

\*The programme runs for 30 weeks (March to November)

\*2 hours of tuition twice a week

\*Tuition is at the school, in the morning

\*BOOST is a 30-week programme during school terms and full training is given

\*As volunteers if you need time away, we work it out

\*The BOOST programme compliments the school programme

\*BOOST supply all of the materials required (laptops, workbooks, resources)

\*BOOST is free to the school and the child


