A Reminder About School Closure Due to Snow

It seems a rarity at the moment, however this is the term that has had the most chance of a snow day in previous years. Each year a reminder is sent out about why a decision is made in regards to our school being open or closed due to snow.

Firstly, the decision to close the school is based on a number of factors. I do realise that a decision made to close a school for a day or more, impacts on families and can put pressure on parents. This decision is not taken lightly and must come down to operating the school safely. Therefore, when making the decision I have to consider the following:

Senior Staff: We have 2 senior staff (Principal, Deputy Principal) whom can make daily operational decisions. They are authorised by the Board of Trustees to make these decisions. Therefore, I would require a minimum of at least myself or the Deputy Principal at school in case these decisions need to be made during the day. Our Deputy Principal has classroom responsibilities and would need to be released for the day.

Teaching Staff: We have 12 fully registered teachers for 271 children. I would require a minimum of 9 to operate the classrooms. Although not all children may

turn up, I have to operate on the premise that they do, and therefore must be assured that I have the teaching staff to cover all classes. Not all of our staff live in town, we have staff who travel from outside of Ashburton, so I must make sure I can have staff at school.

Power and Water: The school must operate with drinking water, operating toilets, classrooms heated to a minimum of 18 degrees and sufficient classroom lighting. If we lose power or water, then we cannot operate.

Safety around Buildings: The school must take all steps possible to have a safe environment. Usually melting snow that freezes following a snowfall, is the most common reason not to open the school. This is because we have multiple pathways that must be cleared and not all access is through the school indoors.

Early Closing: If snow begins falling during the day and road access for motorists starts to become an issue, we may begin advising parents of an early closure via our text system. We would also advertise this on local radio stations and on our facebook page.

Late Opening: If we were unable to open for classes at 9am, we would advertise a later opening time. We would advertise this via our text system and on local radio stations and the facebook page.

Plea<mark>se use these webpages and phone n</mark>umbers – we may not be able to answer the phone at school during a snow event.
