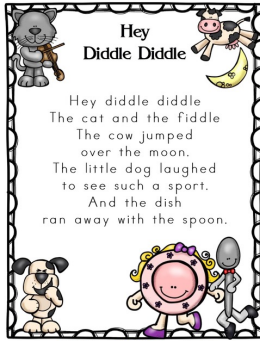


Taskboard for Bubble 1 Children – Rooms 1-4

Task Board 3. Bubble 1.

Phonics

This fortnight we were learning about Uu, Bb, Nn. (previously learnt letters – d, m, a, p, t, o, c, l, e.) Check your child knows the sound each letter then pick from the following ideas to help us learn about these letters.

- Draw pictures that start with that letter
- Find objects around the house that begin with these letters
- Find pictures in books or magazines of these letters
- Use chalk or water and paint brushes to practice making the letters outside

Other ideas

Write 3 letter words for your child to sound out and read back to you. You can use any of the vowels (a, e, i, o, u) eg. tug bug

Word chain activity. Pick a 3 letter word, eg. map, and ask your child how they can change map to cap then to cat then to cot then to not then to hot then to hat etc. You can start with any 3 letter word.

Pick a rhyming family and ask them to write / say as many words as they can from that family eg. "ot" pot, hot, cot, shot, or "at" hat, chat, fat, etc Other families could be "et" "igh" "ay" etc

Writing Ideas

- Keep a diary about what you have been doing at home
- Describe something you can see out your window.
- Write a shopping list or a recipe for something you like to eat.
- Describe your favourite toy.

Draw a picture and either try writing your own sentence or get someone to write it for you.

Reading

Take some time out and read together.

- Afterwards, can you retell the story?
- Can you share what was your favourite part?
- Which picture did you like?

Maths

- Some ideas include:
- Practice counting forwards and backwards.
- Can you name the number that comes before and after?
- Can you write the numbers? Cut numbers out of a magazine and put them in order.
- Name and find different shapes around the house.
